pibinko.org and the Metalliferous Hills Jug Band: mid-year updates and outlook through the end of 2019

pibinko.org operates as a network of professionals, associations, and citizens collaborating on initiatives for protection and promotion of culture, environment, and open innovation. It works mostly on lesser known assets and has various international relations. The network has its hub in the heart of the Tuscan Metalliferous Hills, in the Southern part of the region. This is some 100 km South of Florence, with two main locations in hamlets 400 m above sea level: Torniella -from where you can see the sun rise on Mount Amiata- and Tatti, from where you can see the sun set behind the Elba island. Then, between dawns and dusks, we are strongly committed to projects on rural development, sustainability, digital social innovation, music, and collaborations with other regions and nations.

The network currently operates in two different modes, which are often combined: one is technical, with an engineering background, and one is artistic, with strong musical roots, i.e. the Metalliferous Hills Jug Band (or Jug Band dalle Colline Metallifere, JBCM). Over the past six months this model has been presented to numerous subjects in Italy and abroad. A few folks said that it was not clear...but a lot more found it very interesting and at the cutting edge with respect to audience engagement and outreach.



The network and the activities of its main members

are presented through the <u>pibinko.org website</u>, which is maintained in English, Italian, with occasional content in other languages. On the web site you will find information on <u>services</u>, <u>collaborations</u>, <u>places</u>, and <u>insights</u> on specific topics. We then have a <u>news</u> section, a weekly newsletter reaching several thousands of people, and a <u>calendar</u> with pibinko.org events, and initiatives related to other. In the following page you will find a summary of the first half of 2019, which has been quite packed. As an outlook for the second part of the year: July is still going to be quite animated, with two international initiatives concerning buiometria partecipativa, and a geomusical performance with the JBCM. August should be a little quieter (we like to focus on the off-season part of the year). In September we will have another international BMP presentation. Meanwhile, we are planning October and November activities, and aiming the fourth edition of the Farma Valley and Surroundings Winter Fest.
